

Know the science!

Looking directly at the Sun can cause permanent damage to your eyes. Never look directly at the sun without proper eye protection. *Sunglasses aren't enough*. Learn about ways to safely view the eclipse.

Viewing the eclipse virtually:


If you are not near the path of totality or the sky is cloudy where you live, you can still watch the solar eclipse.






Viewing the eclipse in person:
